

INFORMATION PACK



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And recite the Quran in a slow, (measured) distinct manner.

This competition is named Tarteel al-Qur'an to understand how to recite the Holy Quran, from the Quran itself. In Surah Muzzammil, Ayah 4, Allah SWT says, "..and recite the Quran in a slow (measured), distinct manner."

The aim of this competition is to develop love and a better understanding of the Holy Quran. From children to the elderly, as a community we wish to come closer to the Quran, whether it is through memorising its Ayaat or through discussing the tafsir of its verses, or even listening to the reciters.

Hifz (open for all ages)

The section is divided into 5 categories. Each category has specific Surahs for memorisation. These are:

Group Atfaal - Below 5 years - Sura #89 - Surah Fajr (ayah numbers 1 to 20 only)

Group A - 5 - 7 years - Surah #89 - Fajr

Group B - 8 - 10 years - Surah #89 - Fajr, Surah #82 - Infitar

Group C - 11 - 13 years - Surah #80 - Abasa, Surah #89 - Fajr

Group D - 14 - 16 years - Surah #80 - Abasa, Surah #67 - Mulk

Group D - 17 + years - Surah #80 - Abasa, Surah #68 - Al Qalam

(The Surahs are the same for both genders of all age groups)

Participants will be assessed based on their memorisation, accuracy, makharij and tajweed rules (this will be age appropriate) - with more emphasis on memorisation

Open Quran Recitation

Open Quran recitation is for all participants of aged 5 and above

Group A - 5 to 7 years - Surah #78 - Naba, Surah #80 - Abasa

Group B - 8 to 10 years - Juzz 29

Group C - 11 to 13 years - Anywhere in the Quran Group C - 12 to 16 years - Anywhere in the Quran Group D - 17+ years - Anywhere in the Quran

Participants will be assessed on:

- → Accuracy (incorrect recitation, mistakes of a'raab and letters.)
- → Fluency (pace of the reciter, pausing at appropriate places and controlling breath)
- → Makharij (correct pronunciation of letters and words)
- → Rules of Tajweed (age appropriate)
- → Lahn style of recitation (age appropriate)

<u> Tafsir / Ma'rifat (youth & adults)</u>

This category will be for the following 3 age groups

<u>Junior (11 to 13 years)</u> -

Participant can select any 2 of the below 3 surahs.

#114 - Suratun Naas

#108 - Suratul Kawthar

#103 - Suratul Asr

Youth (14 to 16 years) -

Participant can select any 2 of the below 3 options.

Option 1 - Suratul Isra - ayah numbers 23 & 24

And your Lord has decreed that you not worship except Him, and to parents, good treatment. Whether one or both of them reach old age [while] with you, say not to them [so much as], "uff," and do not repel them but speak to them a noble word.

And lower to them the wing of humility out of mercy and say, "My Lord, have mercy upon them as they brought me up [when I was] small."

Option 2 - Sura Hujurat - ayah number 12

O you who believe! avoid most of suspicion, for surely suspicion in some cases is a sin, and do not spy nor let some of you backbite others. Does one of you like to eat the flesh of his dead brother? But you abhor it; and be careful of (your duty to) Allah, surely Allah is Oft-returning (to mercy), Merciful.

Adult (17+) -

Participants can select any 3 of the below 6 options and prepare.

Judging Criteria for Tafsir / Ma'rifat - Guidelines

Tafsir guidelines for 11-13 and 14-16 year olds

Participants should research and prepare for 2 of the 3 options listed above in advance. They are able to use any reference material to prepare as long as they are able to quote the source of their research if asked. Recommended tafasir references are provided later in this information pack. Participants can quote and refer to a tafsir in any language.

On the day, each candidate will orally present on any one or more ayat/suwer from the ones the candidate has prepared. Therefore come prepared to present any or all. If the presentation goes over the max time limit, marks will be deducted.

Once the participant has used their allotted time to make their oral presentation, the judges will then question the participant. Questions can be on any or all the ayat/ suwer prepared by the participant.

Participants will be allowed to bring written one A4 page of notes (2 sided max), to support them in their presentation.

Participants will also have access to a copy of the Holy Qur'an (in Arabic) for reference.

Judges decision is final.

Tafsir guidelines for (17+) Adults

Participants should research and prepare for **3 of the 6 options given in advance**. They are able to use any reference material to prepare as long as they are able to quote the source of their research if asked. Recommended tafasir references are provided later in this information pack. Participants can quote and refer to a tafsir in any language.

On the day, each participant will be given an allocated time to orally present, on any or all of the ayaat. After completing their presentation, the judges will then question the participant.

Participants will be allowed to bring written one A4 page of notes (2 sided max), to support them in their oral presentation.

Participants will also have access to a copy of the Holy Qur'an (in Arabic) for reference. Judges decision is final.

General Tafseer Marking Guide (for all the groups)

- 1. Understand the main points outlined of the verse (eg historical background)
- 2. Lessons learnt and applicability in one's life
- 3. Ability to answer questions / Clarity of explanation
- 4. Understand with the ability to define and contextualise key Arabic words used in the verses
- 5. Cross referencing to hadith (narrations) or other Quranic verses to extrapolate the meaning
